The motion was unanimously approved.</p> <p><u>5.0 Information Item:</u></p> <p>.1 Open & Operations Plan for 2020-2021 School Year Lyle Bayley reported the “Open & Operations Plan” was developed following the guidelines set forth by the Idaho State Board of Education as well as the local Southwest District Health. The “Open & Operations Plan” is centered on traditional schooling, with students and teachers in the building. The plan is adaptable in accordance with the level of COVID 19 in the community. While we are planning to have school in person, there will also be K-12 on-line options for students who are not comfortable coming to school in person.</p>

Bayley reported after discussion with the principals, looking at surrounding school districts and following the guidelines set forth by the Idaho State Board of Education as well as the local Southwest District Health, would like to propose to start school in the yellow phase “Hybrid Model”, A & B day’s. Wednesday’s would be collaboration and cleaning day. Bayley reported starting in the yellow phase will help teachers be ready to start on line and provides a measure of safety for staff and students.
